A Thought for the Week Ahead

"And there was a certain disciple at Damascus, named Ananias; and to him said the Lord in a vision, Ananias. And he said, Behold, I *am* here Lord." Acts 9:10

This account of Ananias is one of the most remarkable in Acts. First, he is a 'certain disciple'. Just an ordinary guy minding his business. Then Jesus shows up. Ananias' response is amazing ... no fear! He simply responds, "I am here". The Lord then gives him a job to do, and Ananias wants to argue about it! He does not say 'no, I won't do it', but he does ask for clarification. Jesus makes clear to Ananias how important Paul will be to the faith, and Ananias goes and ministers healing to Paul. Ananias knew just what to do and he did it. A miracle occurred. Just another day in the life of a believer. If Ananias could do it, so can we.
