**A Thought for the Week Ahead**

“To wit (to know), that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.” II Corinthians 5:19 – 20

Have you ever thought of yourself as an ambassador? The Apostle Paul says that you are. An ambassador represents the nation that sends him or her in a foreign, often hostile land. An ambassador is always 'on the spot' because they are the personification of the nation they represent. How well do we measure up as ambassadors for Christ?
